Lockridge Networks is committed to providing southern Iowa residents with the opportunity to connect to worldwide resources that will impact how residents live and work. The company plans to expand broadband services to satisfy the growing demand for efficient service in southern Iowa. Financial investments will determine how quickly the company and services grow in the near future. Current private investment will allow the installation 1-2 towers annually assisting in service to 35-70 households a year and will begin as the company desires. State funds would allow for immediate growth and service to potentially over 7,000 households identified by the OCIO over the next 4 years. Lockridge Networks foresees the possibility of installing 12-15 towers over this multi-year period with state funded assistance. When considering the number of households that would potentially see improvement, there could be tremendous impact in Southern Iowa with private funds and state grant contributions.
