


**AFFIDAVIT CONCERNING BROADBAND AVAILABILITY IN IDENTIFIED CENSUS BLOCKS**

I, Jeff Roiland, of lawful age and being duly sworn, do hereby state as follows:

1. I am presently the Chief Executive Officer of Breda Telephone Corp. and its below-listed affiliated companies, doing business as Western Iowa Networks:
  - a. Prairie Telephone Co., Inc.
  - b. Westside Independent Telephone Company
  - c. BTC, Inc.
2. The above-listed companies are public utilities regulated by the Iowa Utilities Board. Business address is 112 East Main St., Breda, IA 51436; telephone number is 712-673-2311; email address is [jroiland@westianet.com](mailto:jroiland@westianet.com).
3. The 132 census blocks in the attached list are in areas which at least one of our companies currently serve with fiber-to-the-premise technology, and which have available broadbands of up to 1,000 Mbps downstream and 500 Mbps upstream.
4. These referenced census blocks were not reported as receiving these broadband speeds as of the June 30, 2018 FCC Form 477 reporting period, but these broadband speeds for these census blocks are being reported, and/or will be reported, on subsequent 477 filings.
5. Of the 132 referenced blocks, 98 blocks have also applied for and received the broadband property tax exemption.
6. These census blocks were included as funded targeted services areas in the application filed with the Iowa Office of the Chief Information Officer, by Western Iowa Wireless, on October 22, 2019.
7. If necessary, our office is able to provide any additional documentation necessary to demonstrate our ability to serve these referenced census blocks today with speeds exceeding the 25/3 Mbps minimum speed threshold for funding.

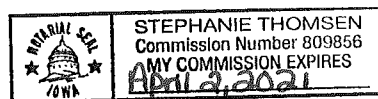

The 132 census blocks listed below, which were included in the above-referenced application, are served today by WIN with Broadband service at speeds exceeding the 25/3 threshold.

**Macedonia, Iowa Telephone Exchange** – 100% overbuilt with FTTH in the summer of 2018, now reported on the FCC Form 477 with downstream and upstream speeds of 1000 Mbps and 500 Mbps, respectively – 98 census blocks (7 Mills County Blocks, 1 Montgomery County Block, and 90 Pottawattamie County Blocks). In addition, we have applied for a broadband property tax exemption, and received approval from the OCIO, for the blocks within this exchange, listed below.

**Area including Maple River, Iowa, west of Carroll, Iowa** – this area was overbuilt with FTTH in the Fall of 2018, now reported on the FCC Form 477 with downstream and upstream speeds of 1000 Mbps and 500 Mbps, respectively – 11 census blocks in Carroll County. Also, census block 190279601001291 which was included in the application, appears to be a non-funded TSA according to version 2 of the broadband availability map.
