The State of Iowa Office of the Chief Information Officer ("Office") received a public comment concerning an Application for Broadband Grant Funds under the State of Iowa Empower Rural Iowa Broadband Grant Program that makes reference to your firm (the comment is attached here for your reference).

The Application in question proposes to install broadband service in areas of the State of Iowa within which your firm may currently provide broadband service at speeds greater than or equal to 25 mbps down and 3 mbps up ("25/3"). In evaluating applications for grant funds, the Office considers whether service is currently available in any of the affected areas of an application.
