Comment

The exact areas of overlap are difficult to determine, because we are having to visually compare our boundaries to the map on the OCIO website. As a result, we are listing each census block in the surrounding area that can receive at least 25/3 today. The counts and percentages below are reflective of the exchange as a whole as we can't determine the exact census blocks that are being overlapped. This proposal overlaps the Windstream exchanges "Ainsworth, Riverside, Lone Tree, and Columbus Junction". In these exchange, Windstream currently offers service to "4,824" locations. "12"% of the locations can get speeds of 25MB or greater and less than 100MB, and "4"% can get speeds over 100MB.
