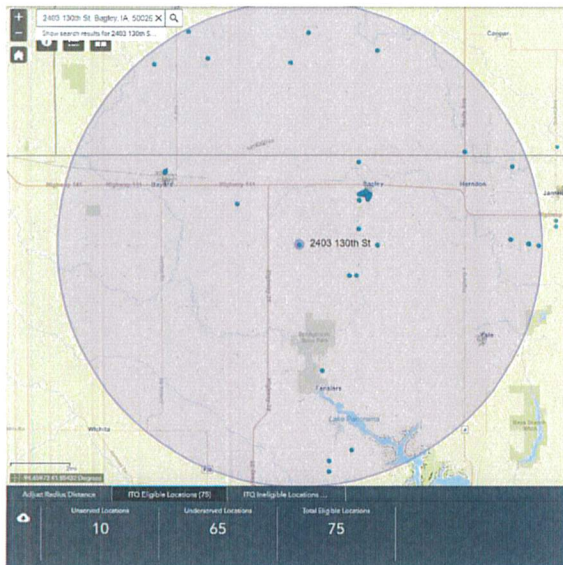

To the Office of the Chief Information Officer of the State of Iowa:

Region XII Council of Governments (COG) is submitting this application on behalf of the City of Bagley and other cities in response to the OCIO Invitation to Qualify for a Broadband Intervention Zone. The community of Bagley, along with other organizations in the identified area have designated the city and the surrounding 8 miles as a geographic area of concern with regards to existing broadband availability. In accordance with the Iowa Broadband Map v.5, the southern portion of the city struggles to gain adequate internet access which has adversely impacted the community.

Along with the immediate residents of the City of Bagley, residents in surrounding communities and the unincorporated areas of the county experience barriers to broadband access as well. Although there are existing providers in the area, economic and geographic barriers have made it increasingly difficult to serve residents in more rural areas.



Region XII COG is proposing that a Broadband Intervention Zone be established for the 200 square mile area in and around the city, located in northern Guthrie County. The prospective intervention zone would bring broadband connectivity to 75 currently underserved residents and businesses in the area as represented below:

The City of Bagley and other cities in the area depend on reliable communication to maintain the health, safety, and education of their residents. It is important that these communities are able to provide the necessary infrastructure to facilitate this for current and future generations.
