The City of Dallas Center is submitting an application in response to the OCIO Invitation to Qualify for a Broadband Intervention Zone to qualify parts of Dallas County around the City of Dallas Center to identify a specific area of geographic concern with regards to existing broadband availability. Expanded broadband will assist area residents thru higher broadband speeds and reliable access to internet services.

The City of Dallas Center will assist local underground contractors in the future installation of fiber optic lines by waving permit fees for contractors to plow, bore, and install fiber lines. The value of this work is estimated to be \$1,000.

It is our hope that the ITQ application and review of same by OCIO will designate the portion of Dallas Center and Dallas County as a geographic area of concern / Intervention Zone for consideration in the next broadband grant program.
