Work:

Broadband investments in the proposed Geographic Area of Concern will help facilitate those who work in agriculture, remote positions, education and more. Much of the under served properties within the Geographic Area of Concern are on agriculture and/or farm production properties. The growing need for broadband is more than evident for this industry. Carroll County is also home to employers such as American Home Shield that employs roughly 500 individuals who all work remotely. Not just in the city of Carroll but within their home in a rural, country setting. Broadband is also necessary for these residents for them to be able to apply for work, study for education and more.

This subfactor takes into consideration whether Broadband investments in the proposed Geographic Area of Concern will help facilitate educational activities. Such education activities may be to acquire knowledge and/or skills, undertaken as part of a person's participation in school, an academic program, extracurricular program, social-emotional development program for students or youths, internship, or professional development program, or in another educational environment.

Education:

Since COVID-19, education has changed in ways that allows classwork and classroom work to be more flexible, including attending school remotely. Broadband within Carroll County is important to support all the needs of our youth and their capability to study and learn. We believe K-12 education is a basic right to all of our youth, it is vital to make sure all the infrastructure is in place to support such a right. In this case, bringing broadband to those under served areas.

This subfactor takes into consideration whether Broadband investments in the proposed Geographic Area of Concern will help facilitate health monitoring services to monitor an individual's health, including with respect to either physical or behavioral health.

Health Monitoring:

Healthcare is another industry that has changed in many ways. One being the offering of health monitoring services and tele-health services provided throughout the Carroll County community. Having sufficient broadband is a necessity for all people to receive these basic services, along with reviewing their online chart to see lab results, and more. Most of the under served properties within our Geographic Area of Concern tend to be of more elderly population, whose healthcare needs tend to increase. Expanding broadband in this area is not only a basic benefit, but one that could help save lives.
