Work:

Broadband communication is an absolute necessity in today's job market. Employers and employees communicate with each other and their customers more so than ever before. In our association we have farmers monitoring employees, markets, and suppliers daily, cement contractors organizing employees, setting up jobs, and scheduling work, nurses working with Doctors, patients, and families advising and supervising care. We have a college professor who is working with almost 100 students on line on a daily basis. The spotty service in our area forcipes these people to do their on-line work elsewhere. We need a serious upgrade.

This subfactor takes into consideration whether Broadband investments in the proposed Geographic Area of Concern will help facilitate educational activities. Such education activities may be to acquire knowledge and/or skills, undertaken as part of a person's participation in school, an academic program, extracurricular program, social-emotional development program for students or youths, internship, or professional development program, or in another educational environment.

Education:

We have high school and college students on our lane. They must go to town to get reliable service. The aforementioned college professor who worked with his students on-line is out of touch if he wants to spend time here. We have senior citizens who would like to be able to access on-line courses, not with the service we have. We have families that would like to use their house here on the weekends, they don't come because the broadband is so undependable their kids can't get access to complete schoolwork.

This subfactor takes into consideration whether Broadband investments in the proposed Geographic Area of Concern will help facilitate health monitoring services to monitor an individual's health, including with respect to either physical or behavioral health.

Health Monitoring:

We have seniors who try to have communications or telemetry with their health care workers remotely, the current system does not support that reliably. We also have nurses who can't do their jobs from here.
