

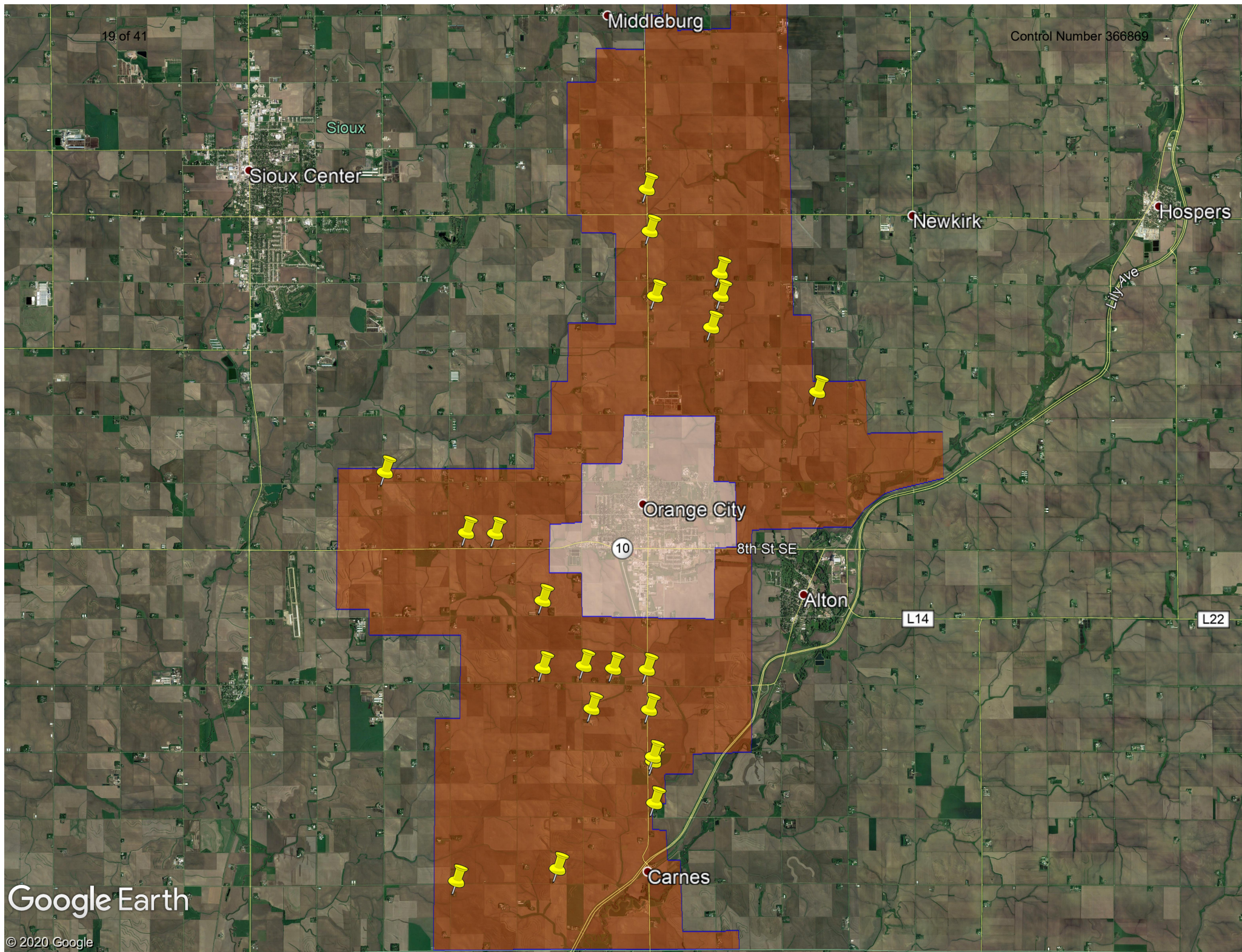

SUPPORT FOR NON-TSA CENSUS BLOCKS

Sections 1.2.11. & 3A.1.1.6. of NOFA #003 confirm that for purposes of this Emergency Program, whether a Census Block constitutes a Targeted Service Area (“TSA”) does not impact the eligibility of the Census Block to receive or utilize incentives available through this Emergency Program.

This Application includes non-TSA Census Blocks (as identified by the Broadband Availability Map v2), with the majority surrounding rural Orange City, Iowa. Premier believes its project, which would support 1 Gbps symmetrical Broadband service (including raw data and Ethernet overheads) would have significant telehealth, telemedicine, distance learning and work from home benefits to these non-TSA Census Blocks as well.

To further support Premier’s inclusion of these non-TSA Census Blocks in its Application, we have included a geographically diverse sample of Broadband Units from the rural areas surrounding Orange City indicating 1) they are unable to receive 25/3 Broadband today, 2) they need higher speeds to meet their needs, especially in light of COVID-19, and 3) they would be interested in receiving Broadband service from Premier.


