AMENDED CERTIFICATE

(Issued October 21, 2002)

On September 24, 2002, River Valley Telephone Cooperative (River Valley) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to amend its certificate of public convenience and necessity to reflect a corporate name change from River Valley Telephone Cooperative to River Valley Telecommunications Cooperative. Also on September 24, 2002, River Valley filed a proposed replacement tariff reflecting the corporate name change. The application and tariff are identified as Docket No. TF-02-497. An order recognizing the corporate name change, approving the replacement tariff, and authorizing the amendment of River Valley's certificate is being issued concurrently with this amended certificate.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:



approved.



CERTIFICATE

(Issued July 13, 1994)

On September 27, 1993, and May 12, 1994, River Valley Telephone Cooperative filed final exchange maps, identified as TF-93-406, reflecting the resolutions of technical errors and boundary discrepancies found in region 11. The maps are approved and will define the service territory for the exchanges.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The certificate issued to River Valley Telephone Cooperative on September 29, 1992, is superseded by this IOWA CODE § 476.29(1) (1993) certificate of public convenience and necessity to furnish land-line local telephone service within the boundaries shown by service territory maps on record on January 1, 1992, with the exception of the following maps, which supersede any earlier maps for the exchanges:

The Wallingford exchange map filed on September 27, 1993, and the Graettinger exchange map filed on May 12, 1994, both identified as TF-

ORDER AND CERTIFICATE

(Issued September 29, 1992)

IOWA CODE § 476.29(12) (1992 Iowa Acts, 74th G.A., S.F. 511, Sec. 1) requires the Utilities Board to issue, without a contested case proceeding, a nonexclusive certificate of public convenience and necessity to each local exchange utility furnishing land-line local telephone service in Iowa.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Pursuant to IOWA ADMIN. CODE 199-22.20(1) (1992), River Valley Telephone Cooperative is granted this certificate of public convenience and necessity to furnish land-line local telephone service within the boundaries shown by the service territory maps on record with the Utilities Board on January 1, 1992.
