South Slope determined the total eligible infrastructure costs to be \$2,090,000 for the Rural Tiffin FTTP Project. South Slope's Empower Rural Iowa Broadband grant request is 50.22%, \$1,049,598, of the total eligible infrastructure costs in the proposed area, with 49.78% being self-funded by South Slope. South Slope is committed to working toward overall community enhancement that includes residents, businesses, and community anchor institutions within the rural areas of Johnson County. Access to high-speed broadband service should be available to every resident regardless of whether they live in town or out in the rural areas. After reviewing the financial feasibility of the project, the locations included in South Slope's application would be too costly to build without funding assistance. Due to the rural nature and relatively low population density, this project would be difficult to justify without the financial assistance from the Empower Rural Iowa Broadband Grants Program. Therefore, the proposed Rural Tiffin FTTP Project will likely not move forward as presented without grant assistance.
