Farmers Cooperative Telephone Company (FCTC) determined the total eligible infrastructure costs to be \$5,457,000 for the Dysart Rural Fiber Project. FCTC's Empower Rural Iowa Broadband grant request is 49.92%, \$2,724,134.40, of the total eligible infrastructure costs in the proposed area, with 50.08% being self-funded by FCTC.

FCTC is committed to working toward overall community enhancement that includes residents, businesses, and community anchor institutions within the rural areas of Benton and Tama County. Access to high-speed broadband service should be available to every resident regardless of whether they live in town or out in the rural areas.

The locations included in FCTC's application would be too costly to build without grant funding assistance. Due to the rural nature and relatively low population density, this project would be difficult to justify without the financial assistance from the Empower Rural Iowa Broadband Grants Program. Therefore, the proposed Dysart Rural Fiber Project will likely not move forward as presented without grant assistance.
