

Windstream was incorporated in 2006, with predecessor companies serving customers for over 60 years. Windstream is a leading provider of advanced network communications and technology solutions for consumers, small businesses, enterprise organizations and carrier partners across the U.S. Windstream offers bundled services, including broadband, security solutions, voice and digital TV to consumers. The company also provides data, cloud solutions, unified communications and managed services to business and enterprise clients. The company supplies core transport solutions on a local and long-haul fiber-optic network spanning approximately 125,000 miles.

As a company, Windstream Services, LLC, currently offers broadband to 4.5 million consumer households, with the majority being served by DSL technology. Of those, 68% receive at least 25/3 Mbps speeds and 43% receive at least 100/20 Mbps. Windstream currently offers broadband to 323,000 small businesses. Of those, 70% receive speeds of at least 25/3 and 53% receive at least 100/20 Mbps.

Windstream acquired Iowa Telecom in 2010. In Iowa Windstream offers broadband to 256,000 households and serves 72,000 customers. Windstream also offers broadband to 31,000 business locations with 12,000 current subscribers.
