OCIO Nofa 006 funding would help to supplement funding needed to cover projected increased costs. Current projections indicate a \$3,564,277 estimated increase in project budget due to today's economic situation. It is estimated that an additional 341 locations, many of which are farms and hog confinements, will be reached that were not in the original ReConnect project.
