Mechanicsville's ILEC area has transitioned to Fiber to the Home (FTTH) technology through funding from Federal high-cost ACAM support. Mechanicsville provided dial tone and dial-up service to our community and then upgraded to ADSL and Coax cable and began our transition to FTTH in 2014 to ensure customers receive the technology and speed they need to succeed. Mechanicsville owns, designs, builds and maintains the network infrastructure. We have seasoned employees who have a commitment to our communities and to providing exceptional services.

Mechanicsville has a proven reputation of deploying broadband services and is led by experienced key staff that can manage their established organization to successfully implement and operate the proposed broadband infrastructure.

Mechanicsville is a certified Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) in the State of Iowa and is in good standing.
