To whom it may concern:

As a supervisor over the majority of rural Warren County, I am invested in IMU Fiber applying for this grant funding to expand the rural broadband territory.

IMU Fiber is submitting an application to provide service to 102 underserved properties with our rural population. IMU Fiber lowest speed offering to customers will be twice the requirement at 200Mbps/200Mbps. The cost to our citizens will be \$83 a month per household. Customers would also have access to speeds up to 1,000Mbps/1,000Mbps (Gig speed) should they choose.

\$83 package will be reasonable and helpful to those customers whose lifestyle will be greatly enhanced by this accessibility that is not there currently. This has been a request to our board for years and as a board, are in full support of providing this through IMU Fiber.
