

**Broadband Grants Program-Empower Rural Iowa, Capital Projects Fund (CPF)****Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) 008**

Covered price plans are for Windstream's proposed application for NOFA 008 (CPF) in Broadband Intervention Zone 28. (Windstream\_NOFA 008\_BIZ28)

Current Windstream Pricing for Fiber to the Premise Plans in and around the Schleswig exchange in Crawford County, Iowa would be as follows:

Windstream's minimum speed plan of 500 Mbps download and 500 Mbps upload, exceeds the minimum required speed for NOFA 008, of 100 Mbps download, and 100 Mbps upload. This affordable price offering exceeds the best speed offerings currently available while also delivering broadband internet with the capability of supporting simultaneous remote work, remote learning, and remote tele-health communications, along with streaming and access to modern means of communication and entertainment.

As indicated in the chart above, all Windstream price plans are eligible for the Affordable Care Plan (ACP), that provides a \$30 monthly subsidy to participants that qualify.

Having reviewed Windstream's project and pricing proposal, we deem it reasonable, and affordable, and offer our support to their application for this round of Capital Projects Funds (NOFA 008).
