Liberty Communications brought Kalona Cooperative Telephone Company of Kalona, Iowa to make a robust team to serve these customers. This partnership was started in 2007.

Since 2007, the partnership has broadened the serving areas to include Keota (where the company originated) Washington, Sigourney, Riverside, Atalissa, Brighton, Kalona, Lone Tree, Ainsworth, Crawfordsville, Wyman and the surrounding rural areas.
