**A RESOLUTION OF THE BREMER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SUPPORTING THE
INSTALLATION OF FIBER OPTICS BY BUTLER-BREMER COMMUNICATIONS TO RURAL
AREAS OF BREMER COUNTY, IOWA**

WHEREAS, Butler-Bremer Communications has identified a need to make improvements to the communication system in parts of rural Bremer County with the installation of fiber optics; and the Bremer County Board of Supervisors fully supports the need for this project.

WHEREAS, Butler-Bremer Communications is applying to the State of Iowa's Empower Rural Iowa Broadband Grant Program to assist with funding.

WHEREAS, investment in infrastructure, such as the proposed fiber project, will greatly benefit businesses, agriculture, and residents alike in the rural areas of Bremer County by providing state-of-the-art broadband services.

WHEREAS, Butler-Bremer Communications' proposed price of \$64.95 for 100/100Mbps internet is affordable for our community.
