To all RFP bidders,

The State evaluation committee has reviewed, evaluated, and scored the proposals received in response to RFP #0720-129-01 issued on July 13, 2020 for Master Data Management Services.

In order to be eligible for an award pursuant to this procurement, proposers were required to have submitted all required documents, passed all Section 4.3 Pass/Fail criteria, and received a minimum 4200 points of a maximum 7000 points on the Section 4.4 Scored Technical criteria.

Consistent with these guidelines, the State of Iowa hereby gives Notice of Intent to Award to the following firm ("Awardee"):

Per the RFP, any Respondent to this RFP that wishes to file an Notice of Intent to Appeal must do so within five days of the date of this notice, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal State holidays. Notices of appeal received after that time will be dismissed.

This Notice of Intent to Award is contingent upon the successful execution of a written contract and, as a result, this Notice does NOT constitute the formation of a contract between the State and the Awardee. The Awardee shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the RFP until a written contract acceptable to the State of Iowa has been executed.

If the Awardee fails to execute a contract with the State for any reason, the State, in its sole discretion, may cancel this Notice of Intent to Award, or withdraw the RFP entirely. The State further reserves the right to cancel the Award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.
