The State evaluation committee has reviewed, evaluated, and scored the bids received in response to RFB #0809-021-01 issued on December 21, 2021 for IT Consulting Services.

In order to be eligible for an award pursuant to this procurement, proposers were required to have submitted all required documents, passed all Section 4.1 Mandatory Specifications, and submitted the lowest responsible bid.

Consistent with these guidelines, the State of Iowa hereby gives Notice of Intent to Award to the following firm ("Awardee"):

Per Section 2.29 of the RFB, any Respondent to this RFB that wishes to file an Notice of Intent to Appeal must do so within five days of the date of this notice, exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal State holidays. Notices of appeal received after that time will be dismissed.

This Notice of Intent to Award is contingent upon the successful execution of a written contract and, as a result, this Notice does NOT constitute the formation of a contract between the State and the Awardee. The Awardee shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the RFB until a written contract acceptable to the State of Iowa has been executed.

If the Awardee fails to execute a contract with the State for any reason, the State, in its sole discretion, may cancel this Notice of Intent to Award, or withdraw the RFB entirely. The State further reserves the right to cancel the Award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.
